Ryan Byrne – Presented an overview of COM's 2020-2023 Equal Employment Opportunity Plan. He brought to our attention that a \$100,000 in funding from the Chancellor's office is predicated on compliance. And, that this plan was suppose to be completed last year and we are actually a year behind because of Covid. We are already one year into this plan.

This plan is applicable to those who apply for employment and the currently employed. Ryan spoke about Title 5 and how we need to align multiple methods set up by CCCCO. Our goal is to have the workforce mirror our student population. We need to focus on our plan for pre-hiring, hiring and post hiring. He would like to see a pool of COM employees who have received special EEO training so that at least one person from this pool can sit on each of COM's hiring screening committees. The classified senate discussed possibilities of how achieving this goal could be accomplished. A copy of his presentation is attached.
